1. Update on Spring fundraiser

Council is checking on some special music to be played between worship and dinner on the 22nd.

SILENT AUCTION ITEMS NEEDED- We are looking for silent auction items that will be available before and during the table event. Everyone is welcome to purchase tickets for the item you like and a drawing will be held at the close of The Festival of Tables. (need not be present to win)

Due to the pending construction that will be taking place on Park Avenue we will need to make some slight changes to our events. The parade route will be moved and our West entrance will be closed off.

Our concession stand will be located closer to the new parade route.

We will be having our "This and That" sale again inside the church.

Council is reviewing the possibility of having another small church event on the North lot due to our limited space and access.

Council will be organizing the project. If you would like to be a part of this event or have ideas to share please contact one of your council members.

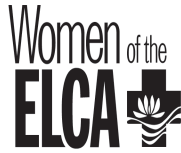
7. Extra-
